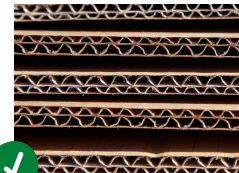
## What's *actually* recyclable?

 **Corrugated Cardboard**



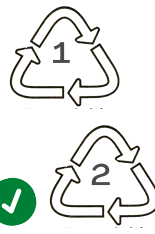
 **Glass Bottles/Jars**

-  Light Bulbs
-  Aluminum Foil/Pans
-  Styrofoam
-  Clothes Hangers
-  Ceramics/Pottery
-  Aerosol Cans
-  Bandage or Cookie Tins
-  Motor Oil or Anti-Freeze Containers
-  Drinking Glasses, Dishes, Broken Glass
-  Carbon or Waxed Paper
-  Shredded Paper, Tissue Paper, Paper Plates, or Napkins
-  **Plastics** with the number **3, 4, 5, 6,** or **7** symbol

*\*Some local retailers will take plastic bags for recycling. Other materials may also be recyclable through other programs, but the Borough is not able to collect the above items.\**
