

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Borough of Flemington is proposing to change the purpose and/ r use of approximately 0.3 acres of Tuccamorgan Park from outdoor and open parkland to a community garden. The community garden will ***be enclosed with an 8-foot deer fence with plots available for rent by all residents of New Jersey on a first come first serve basis. Plots will be 8'x12' with 3' grass pathways. The plots will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis.***
