- 1. Introduction of new members
- 2. Approval of minutes from previous meeting
 - a. Minutes approved
- 3. Ground broken on Lone Eagle
- 4. Several resolutions approved at Council Meeting
 - a. Support Sustainable Jersey
 - b. Designate environmental commission as green team to appoint sub committees
 - c. Apply for EV charging stations grant
 - d. Oppose state regulations on beekeepers
- 5. Agway redevelopment area
 - a. Agway redevelopment committee met with a potential redeveloper
 - Multiple areas for us to be aware (flood plain, water contamination, wetlands) if a project moves forward
- 6. Need for an open space and recreation plan in order to receive green acres funding
 - a. Do we have one?
 - b. Does it need updating (updated every 10 years)?
 - c. Land Conservancy of NJ will work on the plan with grant money from Sustainable NJ
- 7. We are currently active with sustainable NJ but no Bronze certification
- 8. Community solar pilot program
 - a. Potential work with Raritan Township to lease or own a solar field
 - b. Borough buildings for solar panels
 - i. Apartments, town buildings
 - ii. Parking lot
 - iii. Library roof
- 9. Requested plastic bag ordinances from across the state
 - a. We received 4 examples on 2/27/19
 - b. Action item taken by Ms. Boyle to begin working on project
 - c. Discussed generic reusable bags for community businesses in order to alleviate cost
- 10. EV charging stations
 - a. State is accepting applications for the wait list since they are out of funding
 - b. Grants up to 6k for each charging station
 - c. No limit on number of stations
 - d. Mr. Runion has a tentative list of charging locations around town
 - e. State will pay for 80% of 6k on private properties and 100% of 6k on town property
 - Discussion of single charging stations vs dual charging station vs dual smart station
 - f. Average cost is between 3k-8k depending on free standing or on a building facade

- i. Trench digging and power upgrades are biggest expense
- g. Hold seminar for town businesses to see who is interested in getting an EV on their property
 - i. Benefit vs cost
 - ii. Hold a workshop for all interested businesses to complete the grant applications
- h. Can we charge/ should we charge on municipal lot
 - i. Can charge for parking spot or a per cost hour but not for the electricity directly
 - ii. Is there examples of success of charging for EV?
 - iii. Goal is to be revenue neutral
- 11. LEED certification on new construction projects
 - a. Biggest way to earn points is what happens with water run off
- 12. We may want to put in Green construction resolution
 - a. Many projects in the works. Need to quickly move forward with Green recommendation for construction
- 13. Historic district borders may be changing
- 14. Mr. Harris looked into cost of garbage and recycling
 - a. Mayor and Mike Campion will be exploring cost reduction ideas and new companies to reduce cost since our contract is up
 - b. Recycling grant came through and was between 4k and 5k
 - Not a clear answer on if these funds are available for us BUT they are used for recycling
- 15. Businesses not recycling
 - a. Can FCP help us in being involved in contacting these businesses?
 - b. Each businesses has its own garbage service
 - c. Friends of the free public library for educational purposes
- 16. Find out the floodplains in town
- 17. Have we completed natural resources priority for sustainable NJ?
- 18. Flyer in tax bill for educational purposes
 - a. Any educational purposes for Sustainable Jersey(potential if that counts?)
- 19. Mr. Runion suggested that each member take on one (or more) action items from sustainable NJ and form a subcommittee in order to get work done and get the points effectively
- 20. We have two priority items already completed
- 21. Leaders in the community can handle projects and lead subcommittees not just members of the commission or future Green Team Members
- 22. Heat Island effect
 - a. Need more shade trees
- 23. Each member will look at action items from previous Flemington application and come to the next meeting with the status of the action item
