1. RESOLUTION 2020-158: AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF LAMBERTVILLE FOR THE SERVICES OF A BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR

Attorney St. Angelo said a change requested by Lambertville affects the interviewing process; rather than being involved in the initial interviews, Borough representatives will have a chance to interview the applicant chosen by Lambertville. If the Borough doesn't approve of the candidate, it can still leave the arrangement.

Mayor Driver said essentially, Lambertville is hiring the person and the Borough is buying 15 hours of their time. It's a big first step for the Borough to have an administrator, she said. Mr. Harris said Council has no role in the selection process, only the right of refusal.
